

#### Chicago Resiliency Fund 2.0

The Department of Family and Support Services has opened a new round of applications for the Chicago Resiliency Fund 2.0, which will provide a one-time, \$500 relief payment of up to 7,000 eligible Domestic Workers and 10,000 Undocumented Residents of Chicago (\$8.5M in total). The purpose of the fund is to provide relief to low-income Chicagoans who had difficulties accessing prior federal stimulus payments in 2020 and 2021. The previous round, which is still open, is for eligible Chicagoans who claimed adult dependents in their 2019 taxes, such as a college student or disabled relative living in the home. For this round, applicants must meet the below eligibility criteria:

The lessons along with short weekly 'happiness homework' assignments will ultimately prepare you to put these scientific findings into practice. The ultimate goal is for you to feel better and build healthier habits. Parents, teachers, and other professionals supporting teenagers may also find the course beneficial.
